What Documents Are Necessary to Study MBBS in Georgia?

Make sure that you have all of these documents prepared for taking admission to MBBS course Abroad Study in Georgia. Following documents are compulsory for obtaining a MBBS study visa:

- Original passport which should be valid for one year.
- Admission/offer letter processing fee.
- Entirely filled application form for abroad visa for students.
- Required 6 passport-size photos.
- Invitation or Admission letter from the university or the institution.

Bank statement of last six months & a copy of income tax return.

- Photocopies of academic or IELTS score card.
- Photocopies of IELTS and academics score cards.
- Bank certificate of Rs.3-4 Lakhs & bank statement for last 3 months.
- Two ways abroad study tickets of the student.

In Georgia, how long does it take to become a doctor?

The following is the duration of the MBBS Course in Georgia, which includes full-time study and an internship:

- The 6 year MBBS course is offered by Georgian medical universities.
- This involves a five-year full-time academic course and a one-year internship.
- Every year is divided into two six-month semesters.
